The sexual morality of traditional religion tends to be based, not on solid ethical principles, but on a set of taboos about what kinds of sex God does and doesn't want people to have. And while the sex -positive community offers a more thoughtful view of sexual



morality, it still often frames sexuality as positive by seeing it as a spiritual experience.

What are some atheist alternatives to these views? How can atheists view sexual ethics without a belief in God? And how can atheists view sexual transcendence without a belief in the supernatural? "Ask The Social I.Q. Lady"

Dear Social I.Q. Lady,

My sister recently joined a Protestant church. She now wants me to go with her, but I'm incredulous to why ANY woman would choose to subjugate herself to a religion that is so harmful to women. I want to keep our relationship, but convince her to shed this insanity. Is there anything I can say to change her mind? -Natalie

Dear Natalie,

Religion is harmful to everyone. It is harmful to one's thinking process and to one's general well-being. There are vast degrees of harm among religions, no doubt, but patriarchal religions are indeed especially harmful to women. Christianity and Islam are probably the worst offenders. They systematically devalue women excluding them from positions of authority and in many cases, treating them as property.

Your sister is free to believe whatever she likes. She may even find comfort that comes from joining a new group. The good news is that more and more women are leaving the church as they gain independence and become the head of household and breadwinner. As we become educated as a whole, religious sects will find fewer women willing to give them their hard-earned money and precious time.

Engage your sister in stimulating discussions about the origins of life, evolution, and positive Humanism. Allow her to talk about her newfound faith and be an ardent listener. You might discover just what it is that she's getting from her religion that she's not getting elsewhere. Most people want to be accepted. Church can do that for them. Accept your sister as she is and introduce her to new friends who are free from the bondage of religious servitude. Next time she asks you to attend a service agree as long as she returns the favor by attending a meeting of your choice.

Our first meetup in Modesto will be a family picnic with brainstorming session to plan for future locations.





Review: Unmaking War, Remaking Men - Kathleen Barry

Dr. Barry opened her presentation with the surprising assertion that "the AHA is about to come out with an atrocious statement" about prostitution, riveting us to our seats for the next hour and a half of a Sunday afternoon.

She pointed out that the Geneva Convention on the Conduct of War contradicts the UN Declaration of Human Rights, in that it allows for the taking of human life – "expendable life" – in warfare.


Referring to the results of her interviews with US Viet Nam War veterans, she said she got an insight into why men fight: "It's about the 'protection of wives and children." However, she went on to drop another stunner on us with "None of this is biological," a lead-in to her premise that most of the aggressive behavior of human males is a result of cultural conditioning.

Relative to men's attitudes toward rape, Dr. Barry told us that, among other statistics, 83.5% of males believe that "some women are asking for it." Then she

equated violence against women with violence in war. She pointed out that the goal of Army Basic Training is to destroy empathy in the new soldier, and that the Army has revised its training over time in order to make soldiers less empathetic. She said "This is where PTSD begins."

Dr. Barry believes the solution to our problem of violence is to redefine masculinity to entail *empathy* in place of *violence*. Indeed, the premise of her latest book, *Unmaking War, Remaking Men,* is that we can and should take steps in the direction of increased empathy and reduced emphasis on violence.

Dr. Barry's prepared speech was followed by a spirited question and answer session. Thank you, Kathleen Barry, for a very interesting afternoon.

One Pillar in the War on Women (Special to Sacramento Reason)

Rape is the crime that was seldom reported in years past. It is still the crime where the victim is asked what she did to provoke it. Rape is the crime that governmental office holders use as one of their political footballs, tossing around words like legitimate rape, suggesting, that because rape happened, God wanted it. Where did this twisted logic come from?

A cursory look at history will show us that for eons people worshipped goddesses. Goddesses were linked to all that was wise, gentle, and fecund. Then came Christianity and the Bible, and the powers that be had to put the goddesses in their place, put women in their place. Biblical writers turned ancient myths and stories about the goddesses that glorified women into diatribes against them. They preempted and offered these now negative stories as the way to be. Rape happens casually and frequently within the Bible. For example (this occurs in Judges, chapter 9) a father has a high-ranking male guest in his house. Outside is a rowdy gang that objects to the guest. The father says, here is my maiden daughter and my guest's concubine. I give you them to do with as you wish, but do not do any vile thing to my guest.

Is it any wonder that date rape, marital rape, gang rape occurs today in ever increasing and horrendous ways? And that this denigration of women is world wide? While the majority of men do not commit any of these crimes, enough do to make it a societal problem. And the second-class status of women in Hebrew and Muslim nations attest to this ongoing woman hatred. As non-theists, we owe it to society to "out" this history, to point out the misogyny in the Bible. A good start in understanding would be to read Riane Eisler's book, "The Chalice and the Blade." It was published by Harpers in 1987 to wide acclaim from all facets of society. (See below)

Documents the bible's punitive rules and attitudes toward women. Exposes the bible's harmful stereotypes about women as sininciting temptresses and their treatment as male property. Examines biblical teachings about women's "nature," prostitution, sexual assault and incest, so-called uncleanliness, marriage, motherhood, divorce and adultery, grooming, abortion, and homosexuality, as well as "macho" standards for men. A timely warning that the bible is a handbook for the subjugation of women, and that the only true barrier standing between it and women is a secular government.




Eisler convincingly documents the global shift from egalitarian to patriarchal societies, interweaving new archeological evidence and feminist scholarship. 








Hank Kocol



Hank Kocol died April 20, 2013.

Hank is survived by his wife, Cleo, & sons, Henry Kocol and Steven Hall.

Born July 16, 1937, Hank grew up in Chicago, attended Loyola University, received his Master of Science in Chemistry at Purdue University. He spoke 7 languages, worked for the National Bureau of Standards in Washington DC, for the US Public Health Service labs in Las Vegas, later as a health physicist for State of California Radiologic Health. As a health physicist he worked in radiation protection, giving talks worldwide. He retired in 1997.

He was a member of the Renaissance Society, various local free-thinking organizations, & the Sun City Democrats. He founded the Speakers Club in Sun City. A world traveler, he and Cleo logged 16 trips to Hawaii. He was an inveterate reader, enjoyed skydiving, hiking, the symphony, ballet, theater, and never passed a museum without going in.




More specifically for our freethinking community,

President, co-founder of the Sun City Humanists, "life member" of FFRF, and a keystone of HAGSA and the humanist community for many years. He spoke several times to the CSUS Renaissance Society, and at one point was a Director for the Council for Secular Humanism.
